Neighbourhood Plan

On behalf of Felbridge Parish Council, I am replying to your letter dated 11 November, which we discussed at our Parish Council meeting on 1st December. FPC would like to thank you for asking for their views.

FPC strongly support the statements on the Neighbourhood Plan Survey and would prioritise the statements as follows:-

Top priority – Housing, Highways, Environment Middle priority – Business Development, Town Centre Regeneration Low priority – Sustainability, Leisure/Health

FPC also have the following comments to make.

- Housing FPC are concerned about any development of the Imberhorne open space and suggest that the EG Plan should consider minimising the impact on the surrounding villages of any housing development.
- 2. <u>Highways</u> FPC would like to see improvements to the traffic flow along London Road, to the north of East Grinstead.

FPC would also like to point out that the infrastructure of East Grinstead supports many people who live outside of the town's boundary, eg schools, doctors, sports facilities, library etc.
