

The Standen Trail

The Standen Trail links the Mediaeval and Tudor High Street of East Grinstead with the Arts and Crafts treasure house of Standen.

Starting from the town, the route slopes gently down Ship Street and Dunnings Road to the Old Mill public House. Just beyond you turn right into Coombe Hill Road until you reach Medway Drive on your left. At the end of the road a gateway leads into the fields beyond. Follow the paths through the fields, it runs mostly to the right hand side of each field. You might also see the signs for the High Weald Landscape Trail, and you can follow these as far as the top of the hill where you arrive at the rugby field. Look to your left and pick out the tall phone mast and head in that direction. Just beyond is the roadway and opposite is the drive to Standen. Do be careful crossing here and when using the drive to the house.

This trail measures approx 2.5 miles (4 km)

If time is pressing, or your energy levels depleted, there is a bus service passing the driveway to Standen. Metrobus route 84 will return you to East Grinstead (there is a request stop on the side opposite the Standen drive) or you can continue your journey to Three Bridges and Crawley by taking the bus in the other direction. www.metrobus.co.uk 01293 449191

The Standen Trail



Over the fields and far away

*A walking trail to the National Trust's
Arts and Crafts Treasure House
of Standen*



The Standen Trail uses the town's footpaths from the Railway Station until you reach Medway Drive. From there the trail takes you on a track through the fields, so it can be muddy and slippery when wet. You'll be sharing your way with the High Weald Landscape Trail and you might spot some of their markers along the way. When you reach the Rugby field then head for the tall phone mast which leads to the road. Take care crossing and follow the drive opposite to Standen.

If you are running out of time or energy, then you can catch a bus back into town from the stop opposite the Standen driveway. Metrobus Route 84 No service on Sundays or public holidays.

The Standen Trail from the Station is 2 1/2 Miles or 4 Kilometres in distance
