

CCTV Consultation

East Grinstead

Twelve existing CCTV cameras are located in London Road (4) High Street (2), Kings Street, The Railway Station, Church Lane, Cantelupe Road, The Library and Lewes Road. These CCTV cameras are coming to the end of their working life.

These cameras are monitored 24/7 by Sussex Police and play a vital role in helping prevent crime and disorder, reducing the fear of crime and increasing public safety for residents and visitors alike.

Mid Sussex District Council and East Grinstead Town Council have secured funds for the upgrade of existing CCTV cameras in East Grinstead Town Centre.

The Council takes full account of the Surveillance Camera Code Of Practice issued by the Home Office which aims to ensure that all CCTV cameras are

1. Necessary
2. Suitably located
3. Do not negatively impact on local people's privacy
4. Operated appropriately.

Mid Sussex District Council, in partnership with Sussex Police, have reviewed the crime and anti-social behaviour data for these locations which indicates that CCTV coverage, is appropriate, necessary and effective at ten of these twelve locations.

The map below shows the location of the existing CCTV cameras, marked with a pink star, that the council intends to upgrade should the public support this plan.

The two CCTV cameras marked with a blue star (The Library and Church Lane) the Council is proposing to remove as the data shows they are no longer appropriate, necessary or effective.

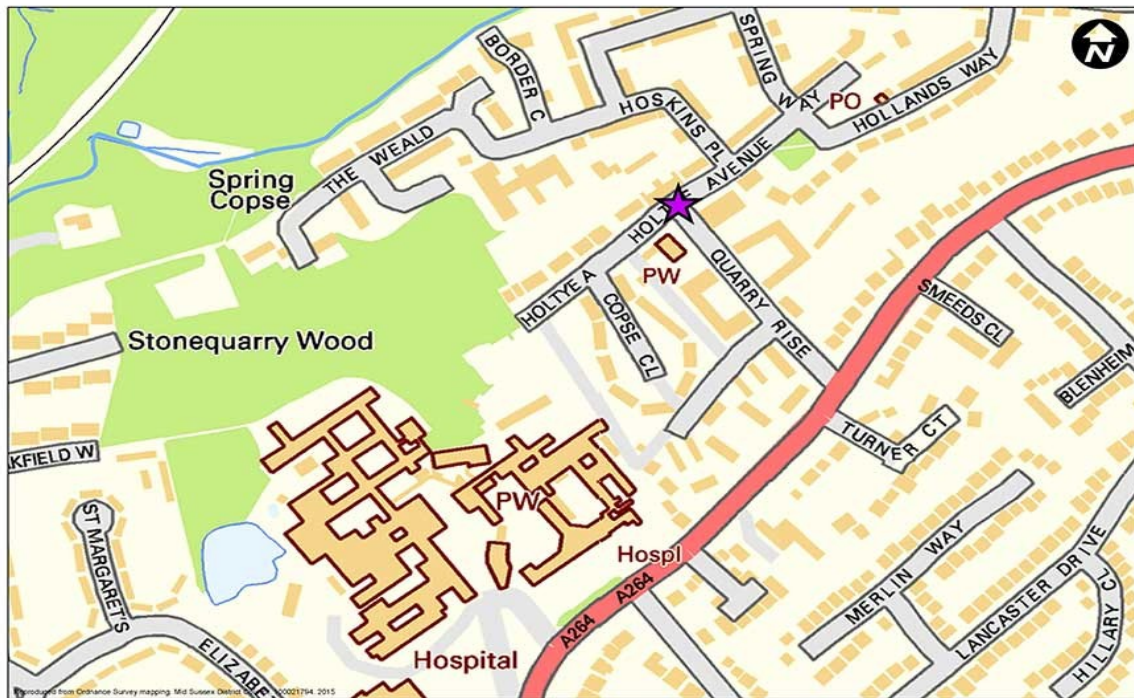
