The Safe Places Scheme is a voluntary scheme and therefore you use the Safe Places Scheme at your own risk. You will inform East Grinstead Town Council if you feel that when using a Safe Place you had concerns about the premises/business being part of the Safe Places Scheme. You must inform your contacts that you have named them and given their contact details to East Grinstead Town Council for this scheme. Your access to the Safe Places Scheme may be withdrawn if your behaviour while using a Safe Place is unacceptable. If you are under the age of 18 then your parent or guardian must sign this form on your behalf. Please note that East Grinstead Council is under no obligation to issue a Safe Places Membership Card and replacement cards, if lost may be charged for.

Data Protection We may use your personal details to help us to give you the best possible service. Some of these may be sensitive. They could include health, ethnic origin or religious beliefs. We may share some or all of them with service providers, the police (in particular related to, but not limited to, suspected hate crimes) or other third parties. We would only do this to help assist you when using the scheme or if the law says we must.
