



What to do If someone with a Safe Places card asks you for help.

Please do

Keep calm

Remember, they may be very scared, confused and upset.

Ask them what they need help with

Take it seriously

Speak clearly and use simple language and short sentences

Read the card they are carrying

Telephone the number(s) written on the card

Keep talking to the young person while you are waiting

Treat them with respect
